INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

The 'Pravara Journal of Science & Technology' is the official academic publication of The Pravara Rural Education Society, Pravaranagar, Loni, Maharashtra State. It is a quarterly journal encompassing all aspects of Science and Technology.

The journal accepts original research article, reviews, short communications etc after rigorous quality checks by the members of the Editorial Board. The double blind peer review system is adopted.

The Editorial Board encourages original and preferably hitherto unpublished articles and reviews of subjects relating to Science and Technology.

Preparation of Manuscript:

Authors are expected to use double spacing throughout the material including notes and references.

Font: Times New Roman.

Font Size: 12

Page numbering:

Page numbering should be done consecutively with the first page containing the following:

- Title
- Author(s) (if more than one, use '&' before the last one and indicate to whom correspondence should be addressed by using * marking)
- Affiliation(s)
- Full address for correspondence, including telephone and fax number and e-mail address

Abstract

- A short abstract (of approximately 250 words) must accompany the material. No abbreviations, others than ones in universal vogue, should be indicated in the abstract.

Key Words

- Please provide a maximum of 5 key words in alphabetical order. Do not repeat words from title.

Symbols and Units

- SI units should be used, e.g.: mg, g, kg, km, m, cm, mm, ppm, cpm, l (litre), ml, s (second), min (minute), h (hour), mol, m^{-1} , kg per ha or kg ha^{-1} (the minus index form is always to be used in tables).
- If a non-standard abbreviation is to be used extensively, it should be defined in full, following the abstract.

Acknowledgements

- Acknowledgements of people, grants, funds, etc. should be placed in a separate section before the References.

Cross-Referencing

- In the text, a reference identified by means of an author's name should be followed by the year of the reference in parentheses and page number(s) where appropriate. When there are more than two authors, only the first author's name should be mentioned, followed by 'et al.'.

Figures

- The term 'Figure' refers to all graphs, photographs & diagrams. TIFF/JPEG images of not less than 300 dpi are to be used.
- Numbering of figures should be done consecutively (1, 2 etc).

Tables

- Each table should be numbered consecutively (1, 2, etc.).
- In tables, footnotes are to be provided.
- Please provide a caption (without abbreviations) to each table.

Ethical Issues:

In case of Clinical trials/Animal studies, all ethical policies shall be followed. The publisher shall have the sole right to reject the manuscript in case of any discrepancies.

Review system:

The double blind peer review is adopted.

Proofs

Proofs will be sent to the corresponding author by e-mail. In the event of any corrections, up to three days shall be given for the same.

Copyright

Authors will be asked, upon acceptance of an article, to transfer copyright of the article to the Publisher.
